For 2026 Eventing Score Recording is an Opt In format. You will have until 9/30 to opt in using the form that can be found on the website. To see your scores posted throughout the year, opt in sooner rather than later.

Anyone doing Intro at a USEA show will need to email Emily since USEA won't record those results.

There has been a change to the recording of the Starter Level in Eventing. In past years, before the USEA recognized Starter, you could qualify for year end awards with same rider/different horse combinations. Now that the level is USEA recognized it will no longer apply to that rule. Only the SEDA levels of Pre Mini Amoeba, Mini Amoeba, Pre Amoeba, Amoeba, and Prestarter will be allowed to use same rider/different horse and still qualify.
