General Information

Eligibility

This show is for Juniors only. A Junior is defined as age 21 or under on the day of the show.



Entry Procedures

- Email entries to: Juniors@SEDARIDERS.org
- Payment by check (mailed) or Paypal (payments@sedariders.org). Make checks payable to: SEDA. Mail checks to: Danielle Aymond, 37463 Cornerview Road, Geismar LA 70734
- If written entry and payment are not received by the closing date, you may not be scheduled.
- Enter early to assure your place. If the show is oversubscribed, entries will be assessed by postmark and added to a waiting list.
- Spots are limited. **Riders may ride a maximum of two dressage tests** (including CT dressage). If the show does not fill by the closing date, competitors will be contacted about adding additional classes. Riders do not have to ride any dressage tests or do a CT to compete in the Money Jump Class.
- A current negative Coggins test must accompany each entry. Horses will NOT be allowed on the showgrounds without it.
- Dogs must be pleasant-natured, leashed at all times, and not disruptive.

Ride Times

Ride times will be published by SEDA on the Thursday before the event. If you provide an email address on your entry, ride times will be emailed to you.

Attire

Casual and tidy, with hard-soled shoes. A properly fitted helmet with chin strap snugly fastened is required for ALL competitors when mounted.

Themed embellishments are permitted (*and encouraged!*) — including ear bonnets, saddle pads, and Glittermarx.

Medical needs of horses such as eye protection will be accommodated.

NOT permitted: leg wraps or blinking lights.

Dressage Schooling

Dressage schooling is available Friday in the indoor arena or the dressage warmup arena (No warmup allowed in the jump arena). Rings will be set, watered, and dragged by 1:00 p.m. Riders are welcome to school earlier, but please be aware that show management may still be watering and dragging.

IMPORTANT: NO jump schooling on Friday or Saturday.

***The Jump Money Class is open to all competitors and consists of one jump round at the rider's chosen level. Entry fee is \$25, with prize money consisting of a \$200 seed pot plus all entry fees collected. Placings will be paid approximately 30%–22%–18%–14%–10%–6%.*

For competitors entered in a Combined Test (CT), the Jump Money Class is an extra jump round and does not replace their CT jumping phase.

*Riders do **not** need to enter a CT to participate. Riders not entered in a CT, or riders competing in multiple CT levels, must specify the level at which they wish to ride their Money Class round on their entry.*

All riders, regardless of jumping level, will compete together in one division. The winner will be determined by the round closest to the posted optimum time.

Special Instructions

READ ME

1. Friday: Show office opens at noon. Schooling starts thereafter. Please check in at the office before riding.
2. At check-in, each rider receives a BINGO card. Complete your BINGO to collect your swag bucket in the office at any point during the show weekend. You will complete your BINGO by talking to other competitors to write down their name in the block that has their unique fact.
3. Saturday morning, before the first ride: the Dressage Judge will be in the show barn to share donuts and encouraging words. Time TBD. Plan to be early.
4. All dressage rides (both Dressage Only and CT dressage) are ridden on Saturday. All jumping takes place on Sunday.
5. After every dressage ride, the rider is asked to approach the judge's box/table. Trainers and parents are welcome and may film. The judge will provide immediate, constructive feedback.
6. The jump course designers will host a course walk-through Saturday, before the competitor party.
7. The competitor party is Saturday night at the competitor barn and will have dinner. Raffle prizes and Dressage HighPoint prizes will be awarded. Don't miss it! Please take the opportunity to meet the host, Lauren Griffin-Kramer and her crew from Zen Dressage. We are very grateful for this generous gift to host the event. They have claimed the title as the MOST FUN barn in SEDA.
8. CT classes are pinned with a victory gallop. If a horse doesn't care for the victory gallop, riders may attend on foot (or with a stick horse).
9. Money Jump class competitors ride their CT jump round first (if in a CT), then return for the money class round after all competitors at their level have finished (do not leave the area). Optimum time wins, but that time is unknown to riders. The pot will be split between the top 6 riders at the show closest to Optimum Time. All money collected for the Money Jump class entries goes directly into the pot for winning! Riders do **not** have to be in a CT or Dressage Only classes in order to compete in the Money Jump Class. **All are welcome!!**
10. Riders are **HIGHLY** encouraged to get a stall and stay all weekend. This is an opportunity to meet other Junior riders, learn from each other, and is NOT just a show. Parents- also take the opportunity to make friends with other horse parents. It takes a village to raise a horse kid!
11. Volunteers are cooking food for us so please plan to eat lunch both days on the show grounds but PLEASE let us know how many plates to expect so we make sure to have enough for everyone but also not over buy. We promise it will be delicious!

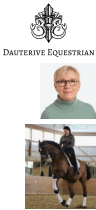
